+ 3 i. Elizabeth³ Pople, born Oct 27, 1611 in Aller, Somersetshire, England; died Oct 18, 1694 in Watertown, Massachusetts.

Generation No. 3

3. Elizabeth³ Pople (William², John¹)^{2,3} was born Oct 27, 1611 in Aller, Somersetshire, England⁴, and died Oct 18, 1694 in Watertown, Massachusetts. She married **Richard Sawtel^{5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13}** Feb 05, 1627/28 in High Ham, Somerset, England, son of John Sawtel and Agnes Pittard. He was born Abt. Apr 01, 1611 in Aller, Somersetshire, England, and died Aug 21, 1694 in Watertown, Massachusetts.

Notes for Elizabeth Pople:

Filmed Parish records for Aller, Somersetshire:

Baptism on 27 Oct 1611 for Elizabetha filia Guilielmi Pople. That would seem to be the right one and they typically christened the children right after birth so the birthdate could possibly be the 26th. (From Robert Heiling research 3/26/2000)

Notes for Richard Sawtel:

The New England Historical and Genealogical Register, Vol. 126, No. 1, January 1972, pp 3-17, pp129-140., Text of article gives detailed information on the family of Richard Sawtell and his children and grandchildren. Also some limited information on his ancestors.

Children: Obadiah Sr., Richard, Jr., Elizabeth, Jonathan, Mary, Hannah, Zachariah, Bethia, Enoch, John, Ruth. Richard and Elizabeth Sawtel arrived from England prior to 1636. This documented in "The Sartwelles In America 1635-1981", Olivia Sartwelle Barton, 1982.

In 1655, Richard and Elizabeth moved the family from Watertown to Groton, Mass where Richard received a grant of 20 acres of land as one of the original proprietors.

In Watertown records the name is spelled Sawtel. In Groton records the name is spelled Sawtell.

After severe Indian raids on 13 Mar 1676, Richard and Elizabeth moved the family back to Watertown where they remained until their deaths. At least one of the children returned to Groton (Obidiah).

The name is spelled Sawtelle, Sawtel, Sawtell, Sartwell, Sartell, Sawtle, Sattle, Satle, and even Satley in the records.

Terrence H. Fregly, Terrence H. Fregly Research, (Internet World Family Tree), "CD-ROM," According to this source, Richard Sawtel may have used the alias Dolman. This is the source for Richard's birthplace as Aller,

Somerset, England.

According to one source, Richard Sawtel died on 14 Sep 1694 and this is documented in his will.

- 4 i. Richard⁴ Sawtell, Jr.¹⁴, born Bef. 1635 in England; died Aug 09, 1676.

Notes for Richard Sawtell, Jr.:

Richard Sawtel, Jr. perhaps born and died in England. Death recorded in Watertown, Mass. Vital Records as 9 Aug 1676, "according to England." Birth date Bef 1635 assumed because Richard and Elizabeth Sawtel were probably in Watertown prior to 30 Aug 1635 as that was the date land distribution was restricted in the township. Richard, Sr. was already a land holder on that date according to town records.

Richard Jr. served in King Phillip's War under Capt. Jonathan Remington at the Billerica, Mass. garrison in 1675 and 1676. He probably died in military service and is not necessarily the eldest son. This according to: The New England Historical and Genealogical Register, Vol. 126, No. 1, January 1972, pp 3-17, pp129-140.

- 5 ii. Elizabeth Sawtell¹⁴, born May 01, 1638 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died Abt. 1700. She married Sterling.

Notes for Elizabeth Sawtell:

Never married. Death date approximate.

- 6 iii. Jonathan Sawtell^{14,15}, born Aug 24, 1639 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died Jul 06, 1690 in Groton, Massachusetts. He married Mary Tarbell Jul 03, 1665; died Apr 25, 1676 in Watertown, Massachusetts.

Notes for Jonathan Sawtell:

- 7 iv. Mary Sawtell¹⁶, born Nov 19, 1640 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died in Charlestown, Massachusetts. She married Sterling Apr 19, 1664.

- 8 v. Hannah Sawtell^{16,17,18}, born Dec 10, 1642 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died Feb 18, 1722/23 in Woburn, Massachusetts. She married Increase Winn¹⁹ Jul 13, 1665 in Woburn, Massachusetts; born Dec 05, 1641 in Woburn, Massachusetts; died Dec 14, 1690 in Woburn, Massachusetts.

Notes for Increase Winn:

Increase Winn was of Woburn, Mass.

- 9 vi. Zachariah Sawtell^{20,21,22}, born May 26, 1643 in Watertown Massachusetts; died Mar 17, 1691/92 in Groton Massachusetts. He married (1) Elizabeth Harris^{23,24} Apr 13, 1669 in Malden Massachusetts²⁵; died 1677. He married (2) Anna Parker Jul 13, 1684; born Nov 16, 1663 in Chelmsford Massachusetts.

Notes for Zachariah Sawtell:

Groton Massachusetts is now Shirley Massachusetts.

Served in King Phillip's War in 1675-1676 when Groton was burned. This according to: The New England Historical and Genealogical Register, Vol. 126, No. 1, January 1972, pp 3-17, pp129-140.

Notes for Elizabeth Harris:

Elizabeth Harris died of Smallpox in 1677

- 10 vii. Bethia Sawtell²⁶, born Abt. 1646 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died 1714. She married John Green 1702.

Notes for John Green:

John Green was from Watertown, Mass.

- 11 viii. Enoch Sawtell^{26,27}, born Abt. 1656 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died 1741 in Watertown, Massachusetts. He married Susanna Randell Bef. 1687.

Notes for Enoch Sawtell:

Exact birthdate unknown. Birth order may be incorrect due to assumed dates.

- 12 ix. John Sawtell²⁸, born Aft. 1648 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died Abt. 1700. He married Elizabeth Post.

Notes for John Sawtell:

Exact birthdate unknown. Birth order may be incorrect due to assumed dates.

- 13 x. Obadiah Sawtell^{29,30,31,32,33}, born Sep 14, 1648 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died Mar 20, 1739/40 in Groton, Massachusetts. He married Hannah Lawrence³⁴ Abt. 1680; born Mar 24, 1661/62 in Watertown, Massachusetts; died Abt. 1741 in Groton, Massachusetts.

Notes for Obadiah Sawtell:

Children: Obadiah, Jr., Elnathan, Josiah, Hannah, Abigail, Hezechiah.

Note: Change in surname spelling from previous generation's Sawtel.

Obidiah and Hannah had twelve children. We have records for only the six born in Groton, Mass.
